The Accrediting Commission for Schools, Western Association of Schools and Colleges (ACS WASC) announces the action taken at the 2021 Commission Meeting. The ACS WASC Commissioners have determined King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang International Demonstration School (6-12) meets the ACS WASC criteria for candidacy. This status is based on all of the information provided by the school, including the initial visit report, and the satisfactory completion of the initial accreditation visit.

It is the decision of the Commission to grant King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang International Demonstration School (6-12) Candidacy Status through June 30, 2024, with a special visit in the second semester of the 2021-2022 school year to review progress in addressing the residential program (See *Focus on Learning International* 2020, Residential Life criteria.)

In preparation for the special visit, the schools is asked to prepare a written progress report. The report should include the progress being made in meeting the recommendations of the initial visit visiting committee, especially in the area of the residential program. Instructions for preparing and submitting this report will be provided to the school.

Prior to the end of this initial candidacy period, schools must complete a self-study assessment and submit a self-study report, including the progress made in meeting the recommendations of the initial visit visiting committee. Self-study training will be provided and schools will be expected to have key staff participate in these training sessions. An ACS WASC visiting committee will conduct a visit to review the self-study findings and supporting evidence, conduct classroom observations, and dialogue with all stakeholders. The committee will evaluate the programs and operations and the impact on student learning.

Candidacy status is conditioned upon King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang International Demonstration School's continued adherence with the ACS WASC policies, procedures, and criteria. One requirement is the obligation of schools to notify ACS WASC of any changes which might be substantive in nature with an explanation of the change and the anticipated effect on the educational program (see attached).

Another requirement is that schools and districts annually contribute members to participate on visiting committees. This is particularly helpful to newly accredited schools in order to gain a better understanding of the accreditation process. New members can sign up to serve on a visiting committee on the ACS WASC website at www.acswasc.org. Failure to maintain compliance with said policies, procedures, and standards is grounds for modification and/or withdrawal of candidacy.



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The approval of candidacy status entitles you to use the following phrase on transcripts or in school advertising: **Candidate for Accreditation. Approved by the Accrediting Commission for Schools, Western Association of Schools and Colleges**, until such time as the school has been granted accreditation or candidacy has either lapsed or been denied. The school is NOT authorized to use the word "accredited" or "accredited by" until accreditation has been granted by the Commission. Candidate schools MAY NOT use the ACS WASC logo or ACS WASC accreditation stamp on transcripts or school advertising.

If you choose to disclose your candidacy status in any communications with the public, you must specify the programs or grade levels which are covered by the candidacy status. You must also include the name, address and website of the Accrediting Commission for Schools, Western Association of Schools and Colleges in the same communication. The information to include is:
